Regional Waste Management Facility

All of the items listed below can be recycled at the Regional Waste Management Facility and most can be recycled by residents for FREE!

- Cardboard
- Greenwaste
- Steel cans
- Timber
- Car batteries
- Tyres
- Glass bottles
- Aluminium cans
- Batteries
- Metal
- Cooking oil
- E-waste

To ensure that materials get properly recycled, materials must be separated as much as possible by using the separate cages at the Transfer Station

Rediscovery Centre

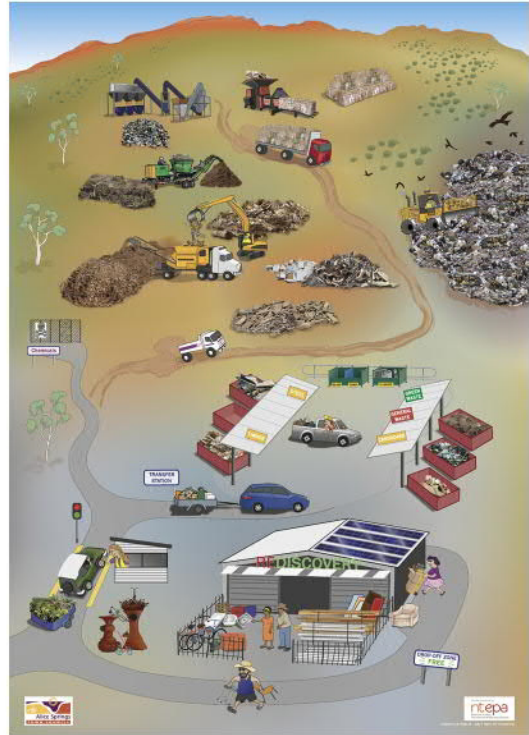
Visit the Rediscovery Centre to find pre-loved, reusable items. The Rediscovery Centre also offers free drop-off for:

- Household items
- Furniture
- Building materials
- Toys

The drop-off zone is located at the side of the Rediscovery Centre building.

What can't be recycled in Alice Springs?

Plastics that are not covered by the Container Deposit Scheme cannot be recycled at this stage. These plastics include items such as unflavoured (regular) milk bottles, yoghurt and margarine cartons, cordial bottles, and other household plastics.
