2. COMMON SEAL – GRANT FUNDING AGREEMENT

Council has received advice from the Department of Tourism and Culture that its application for the construction of lights on Albrecht Oval has been successful. The grant is for \$600,000 (ex GST). Council contribution is \$600,000 to match the \$600,000 commitment by the Northern Territory Government.

IT IS RECOMMENDED that the Alice Springs Town Council common seal be affixed to the Grant Funding Agreement between Alice Springs Town Council and the Northern Territory Government for the Capital Grant – Albrecht Oval Lights for \$600,000.
